

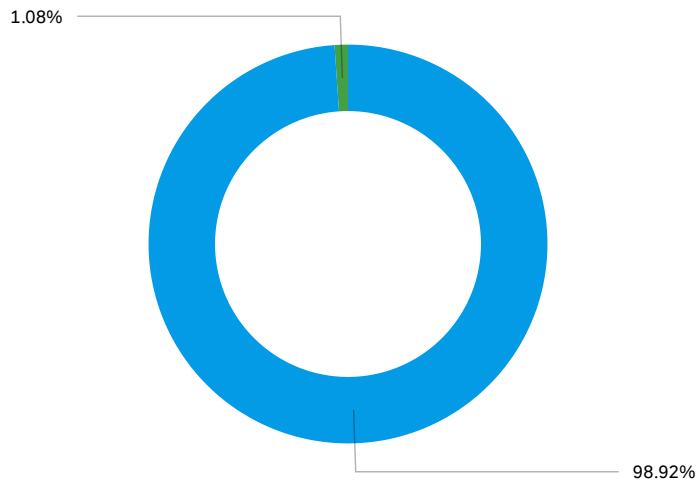

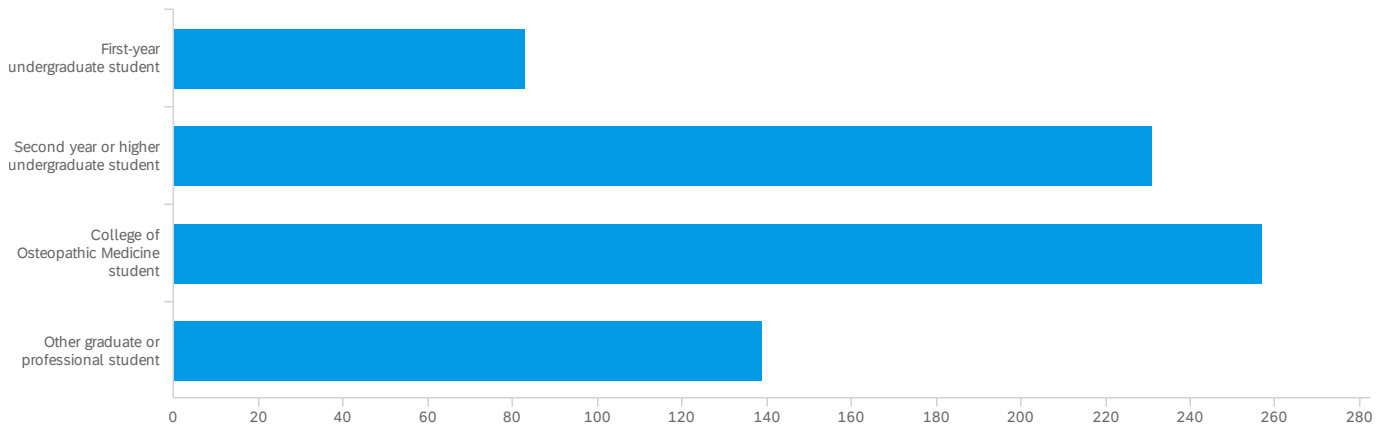

## Q2 - What is your current class standing?

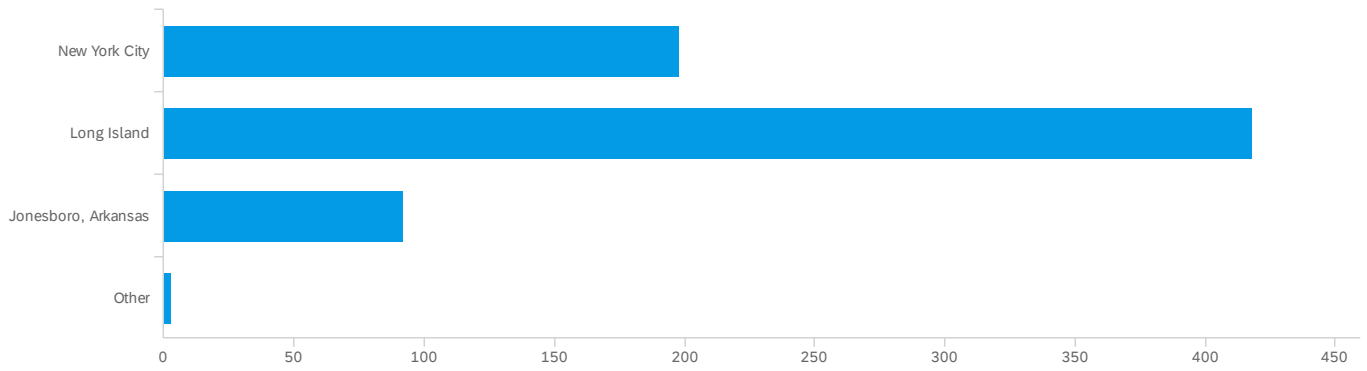

### Q3 - Please select which campus you are based at:

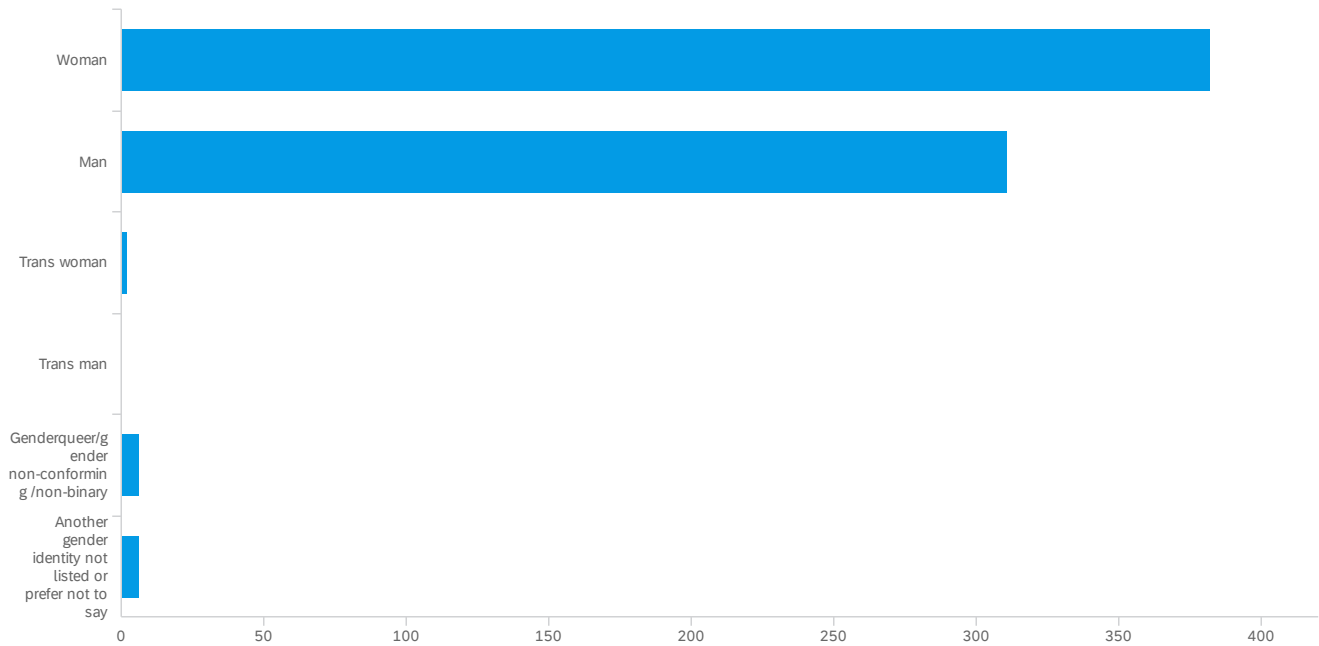

## Q4 - What term best describes your gender identity?

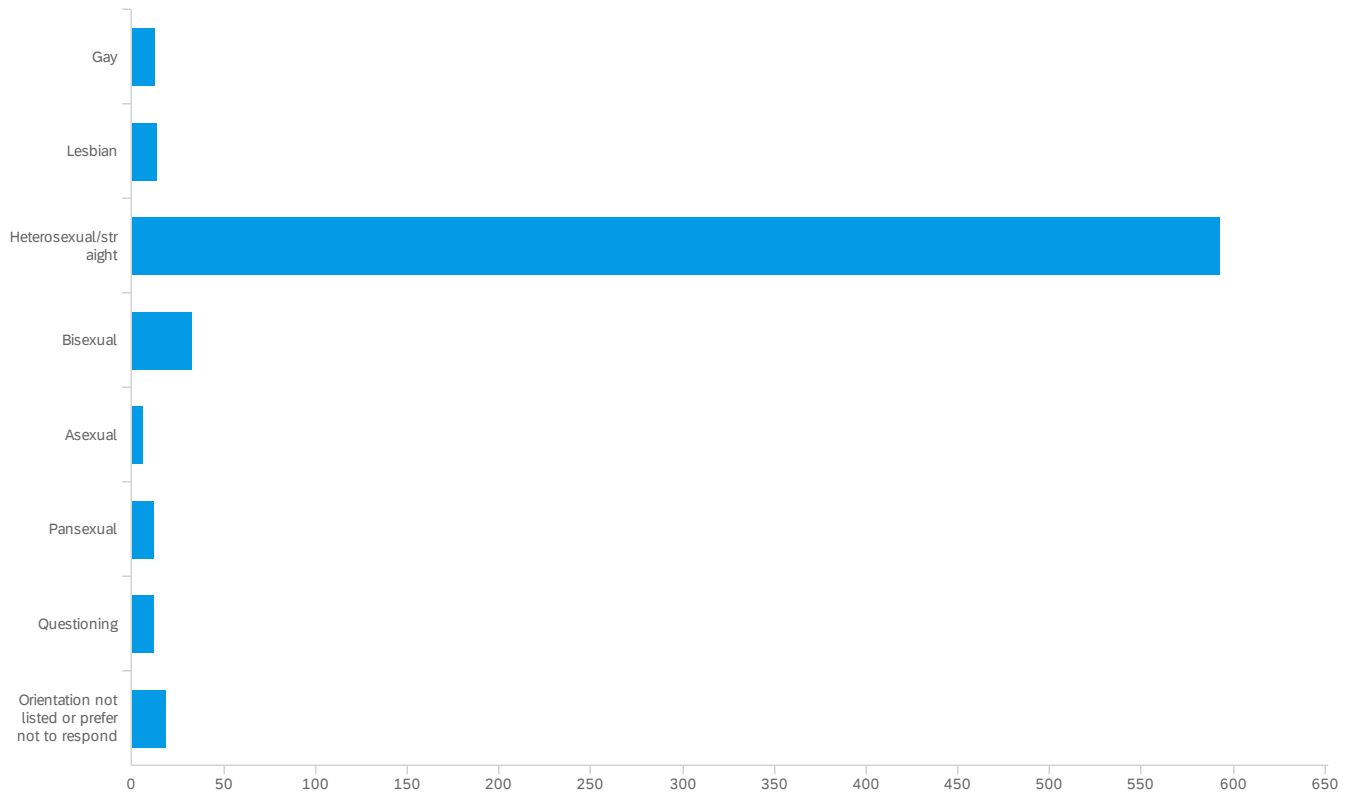

## Q5 - What term best describes your sexual orientation?

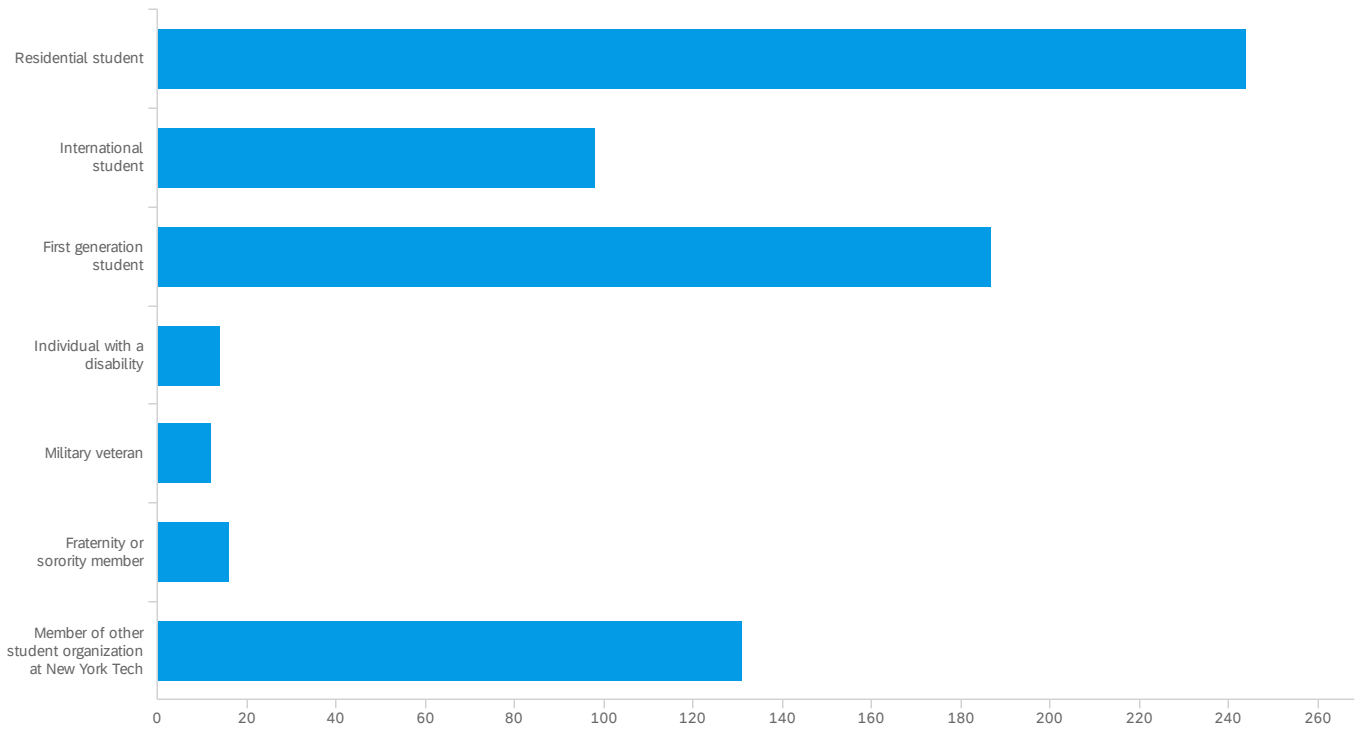

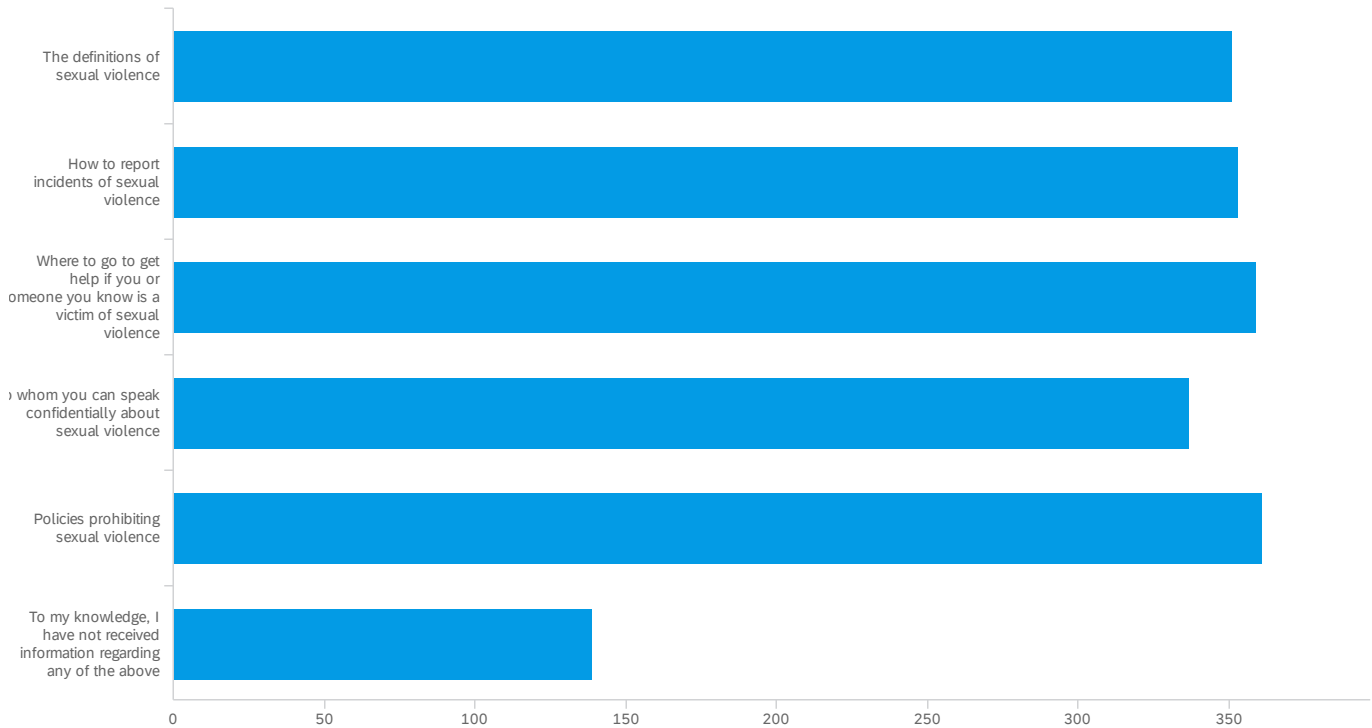

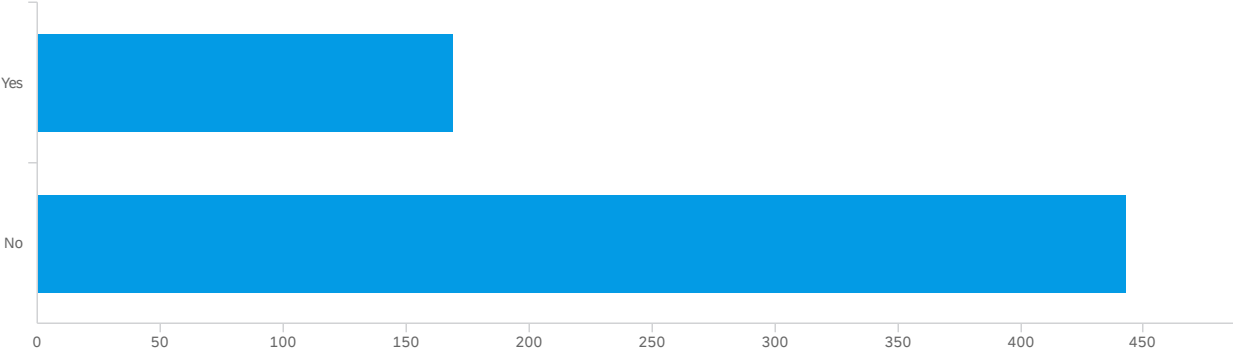

# Q10 - Do you know who the Title IX Coordinator is at New York Tech?

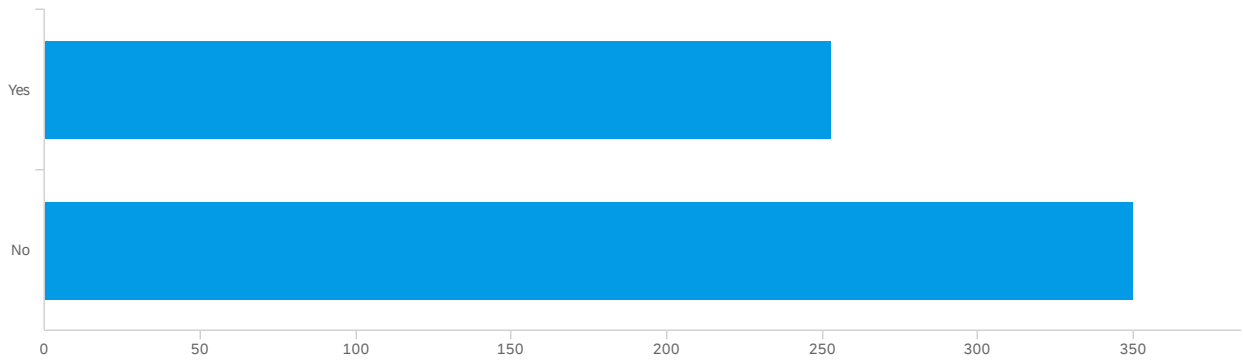

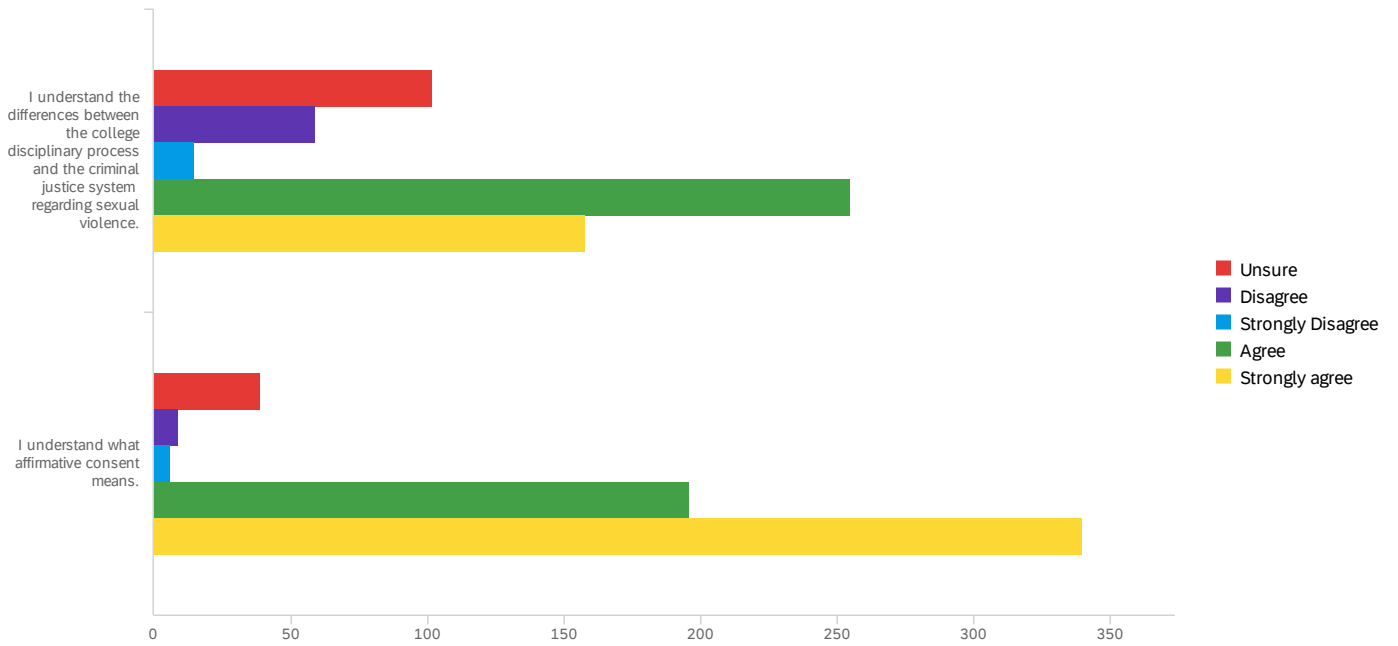

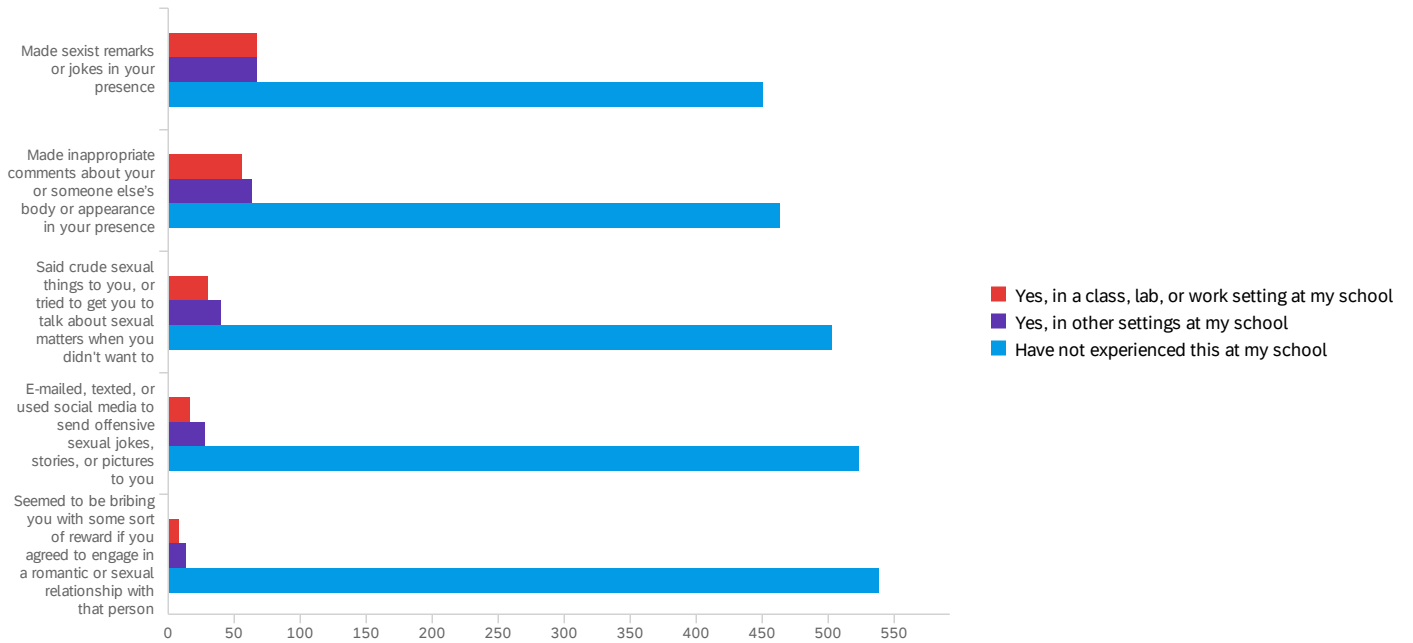

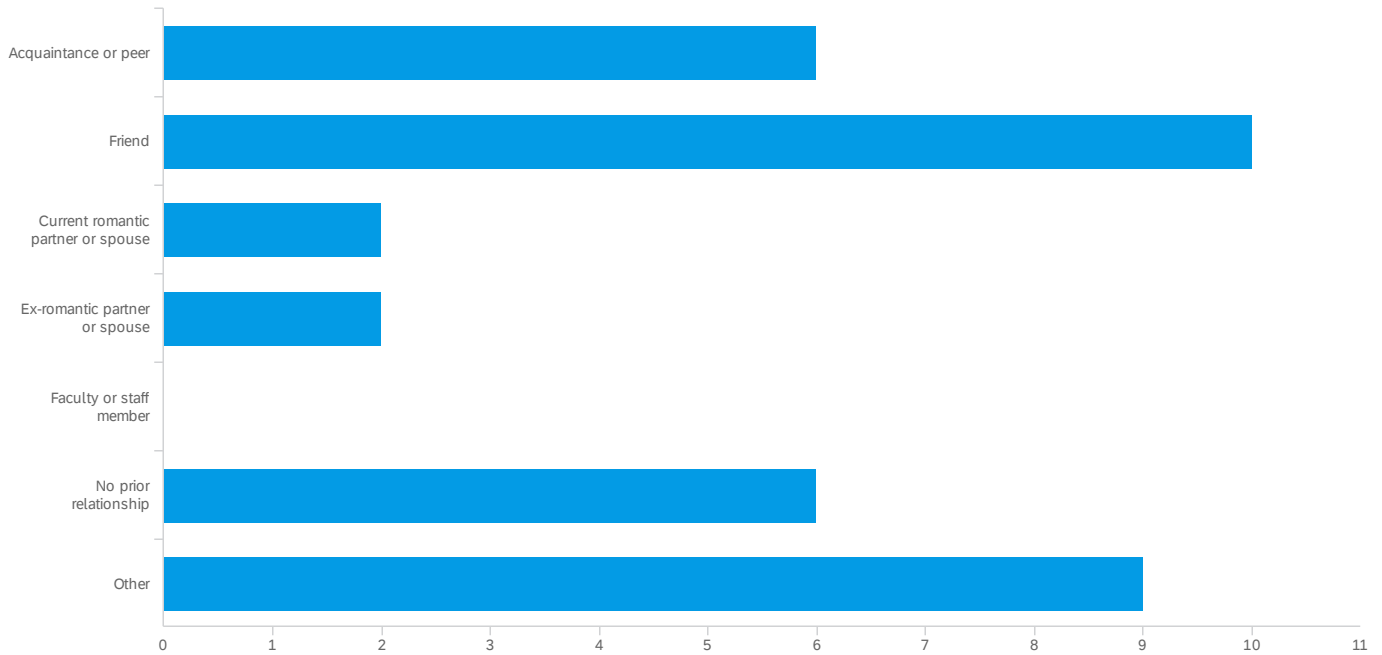

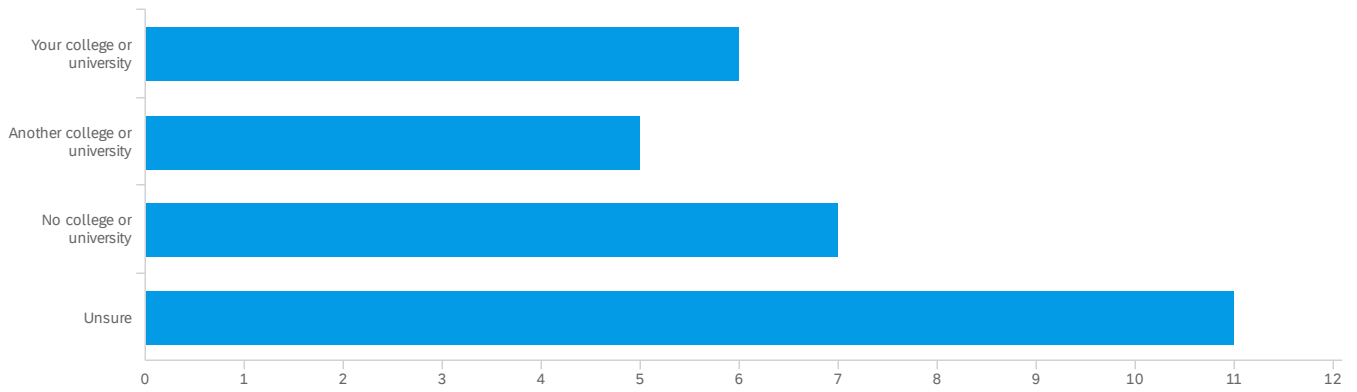
Q21 - What is or was your relationship with the person(s) who conducted this unwanted behavior? (select all that apply)

## Q22 - Was the person(s) affiliated with: (select all that apply)

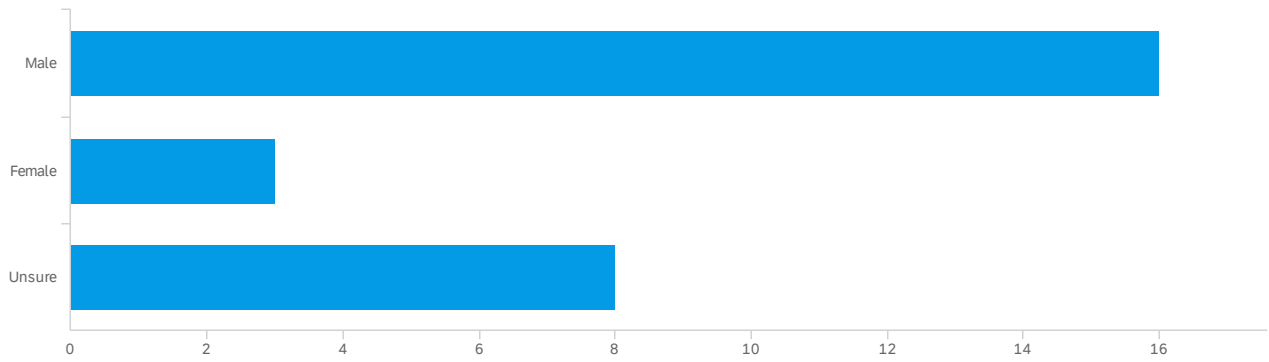

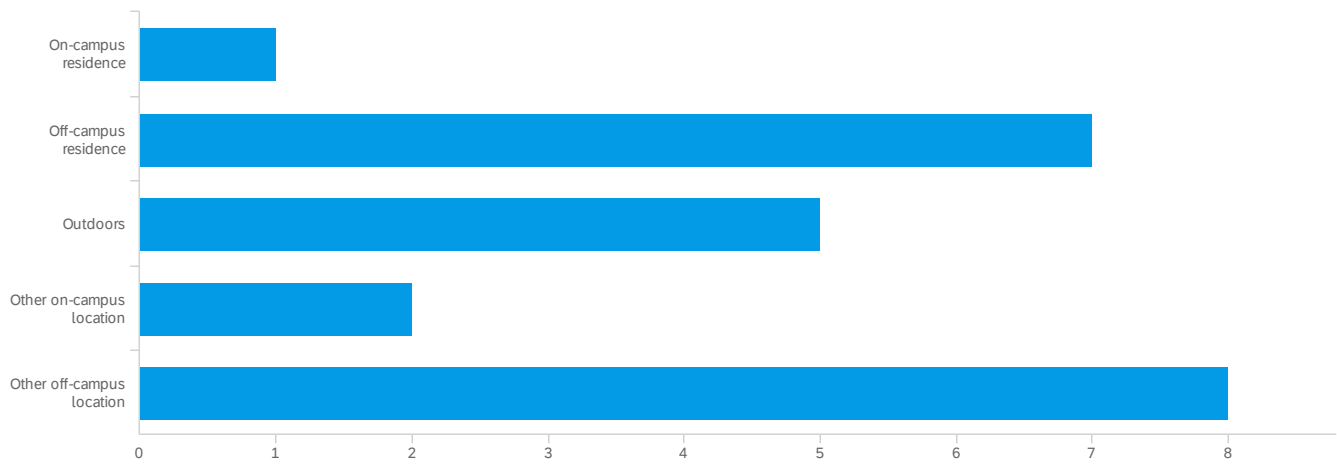
Q23 - What was the sex of the individual(s)? (select all that apply)

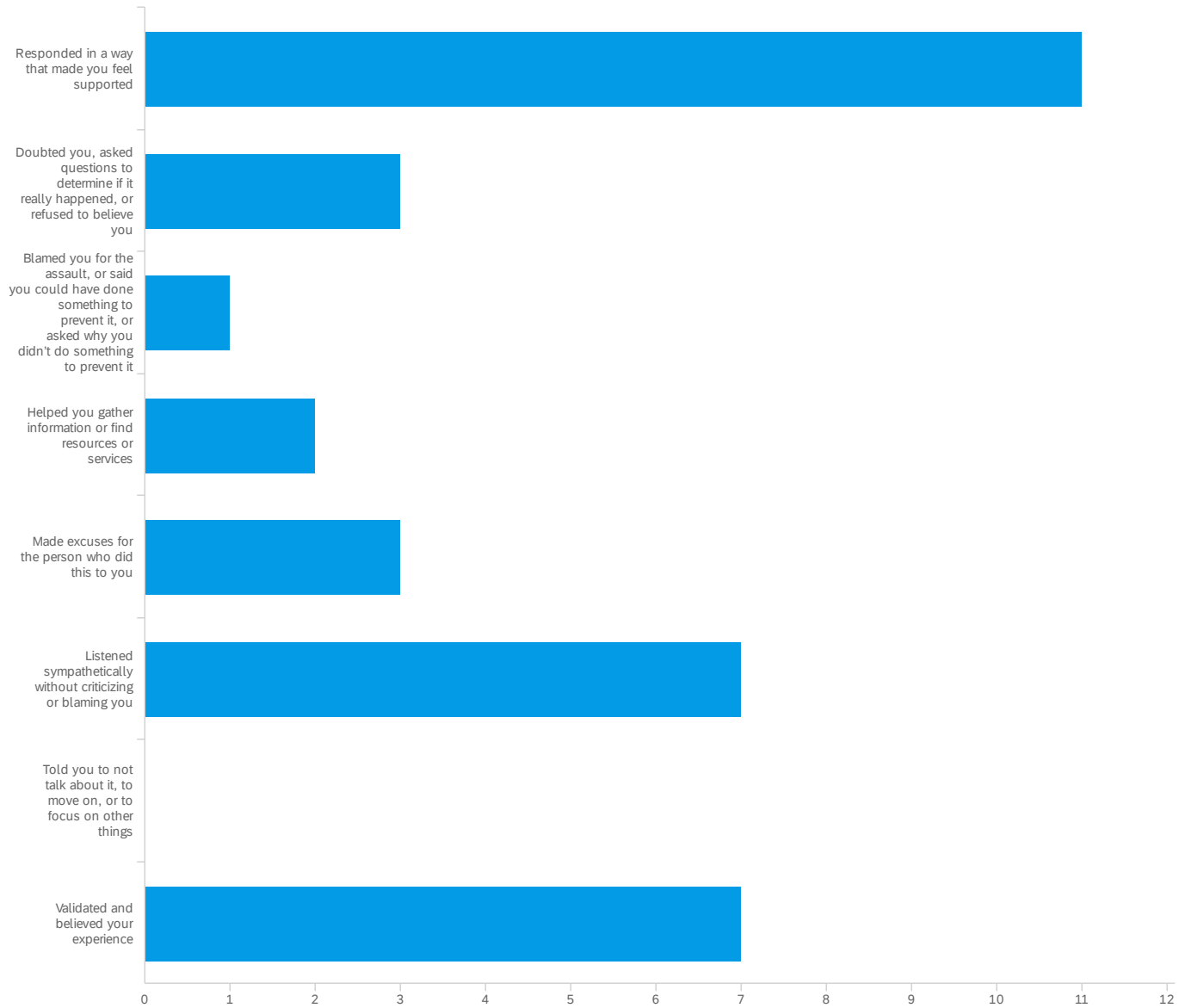
## Q25 - Who did you tell about the incident? (select all that apply)

Q26 - What kind of responses did you receive from those you told or reported to? (select all that apply)



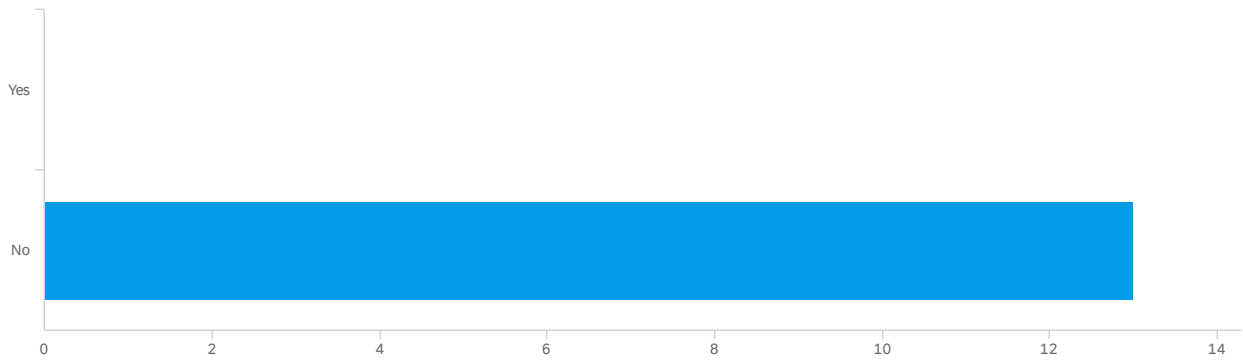

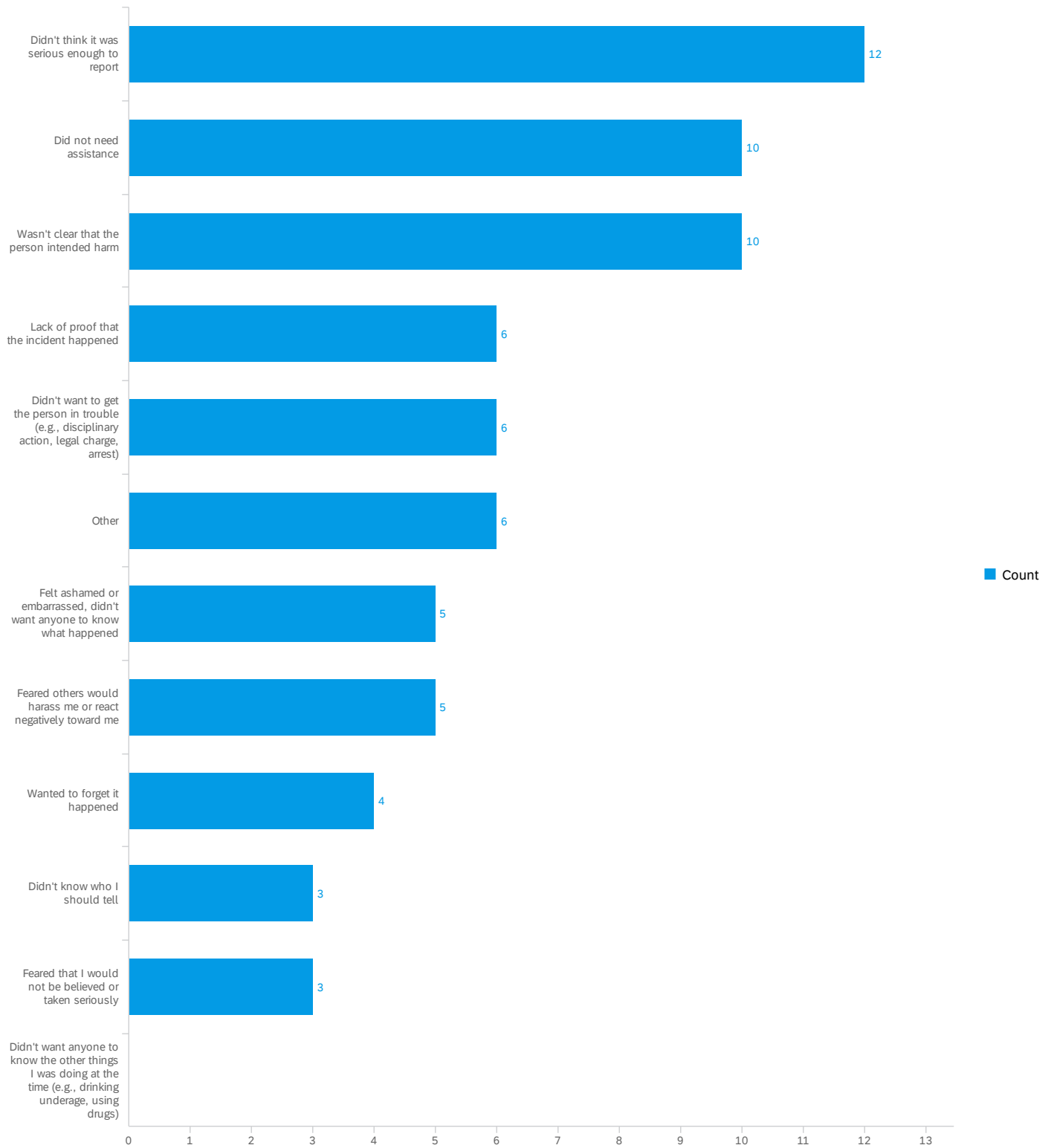

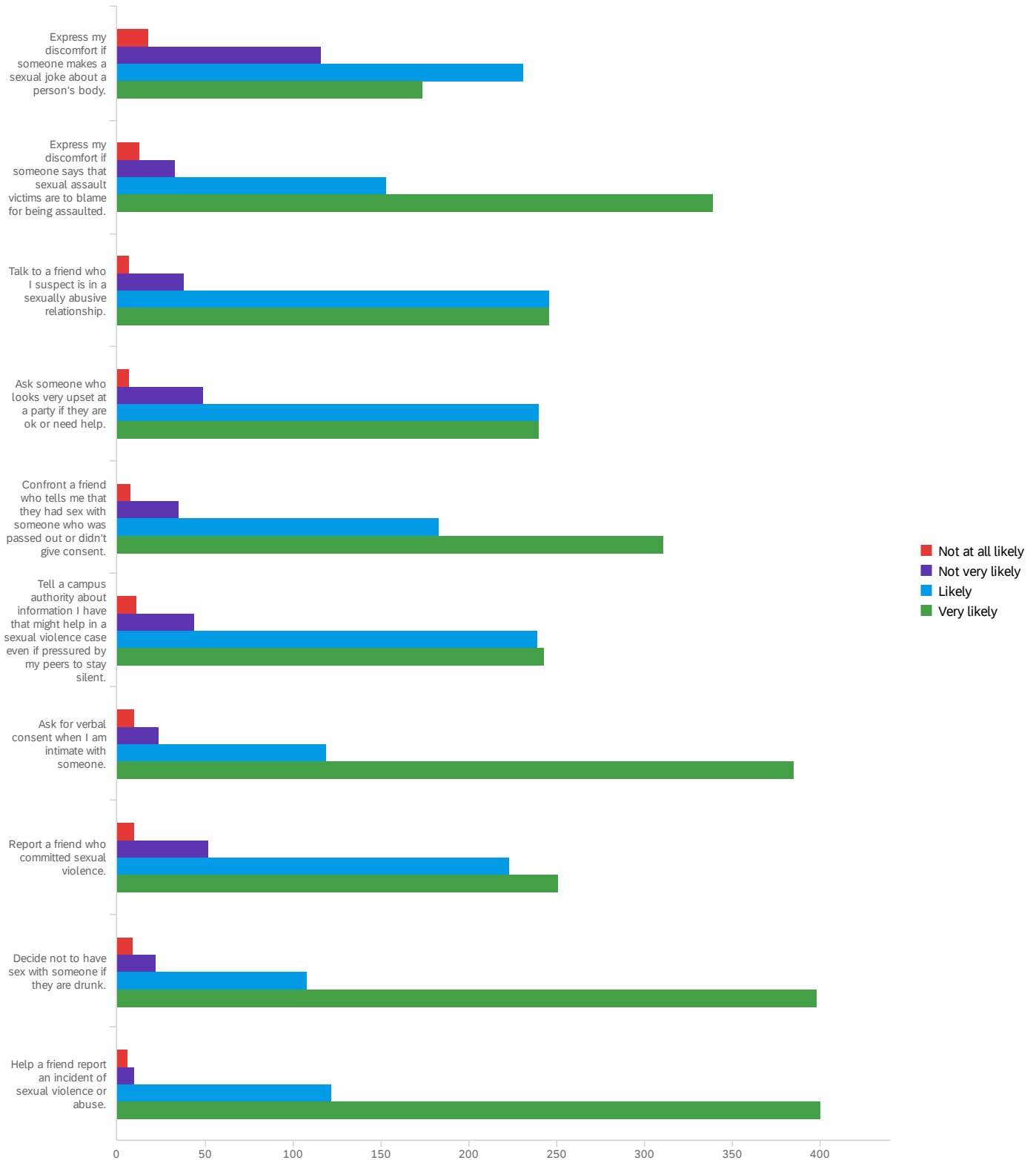
Q30 - Has anyone had or attempted to have unwanted sexual contact with you prior to you going to college?

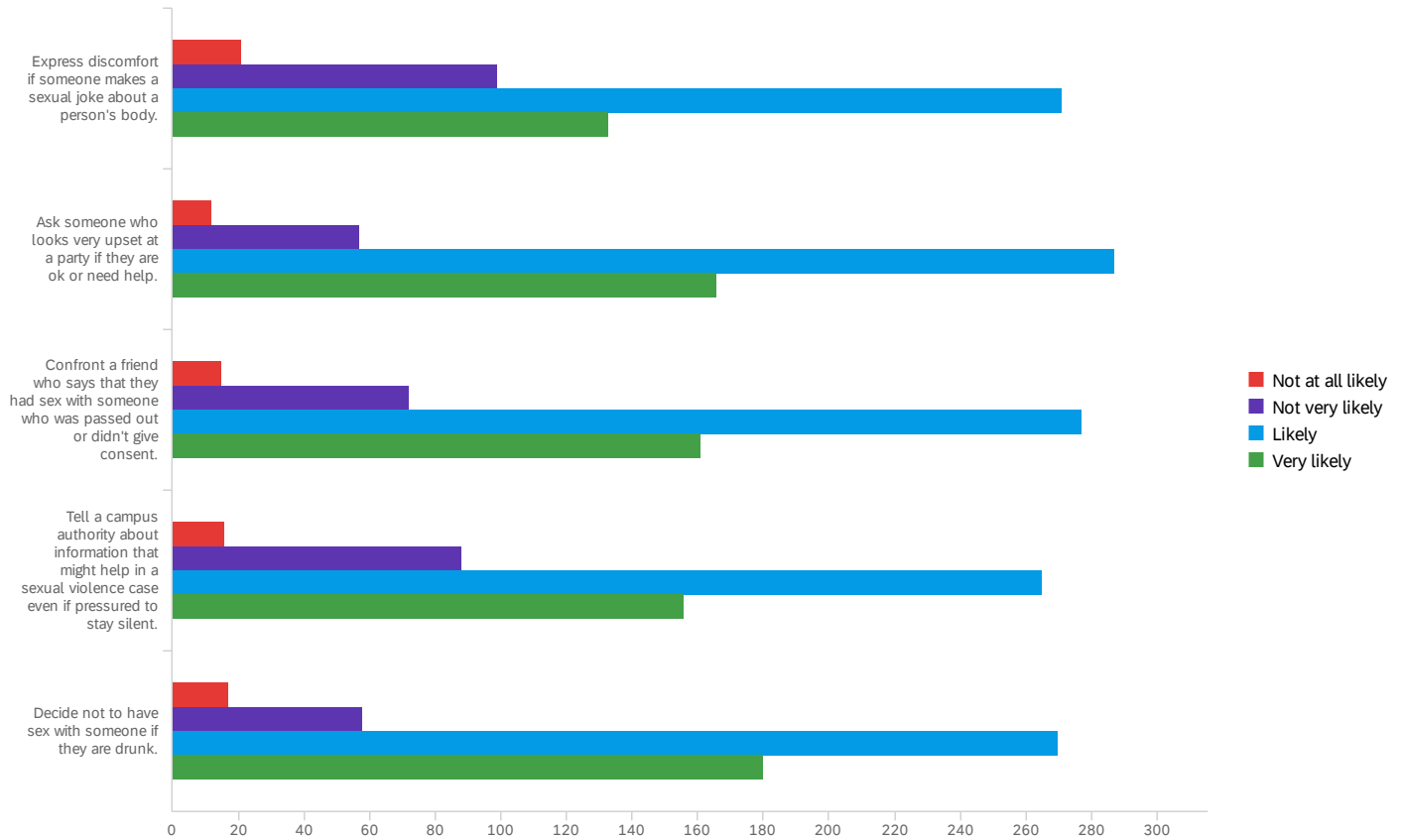

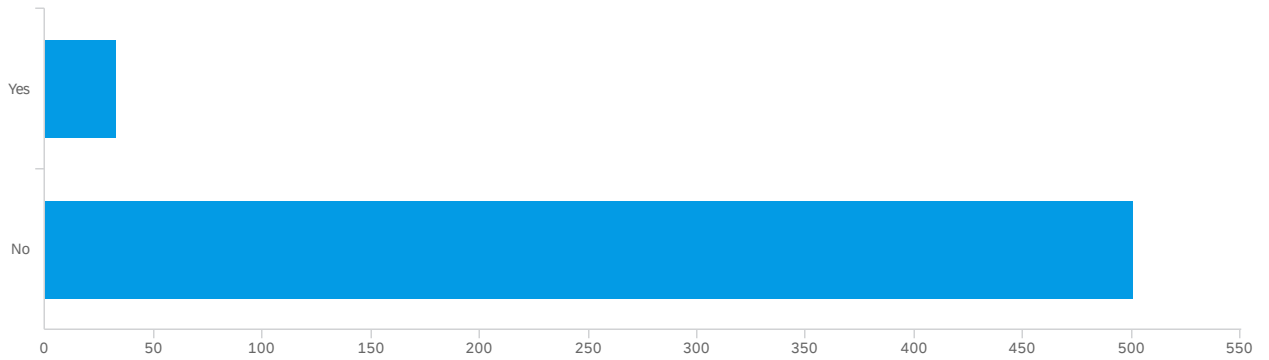

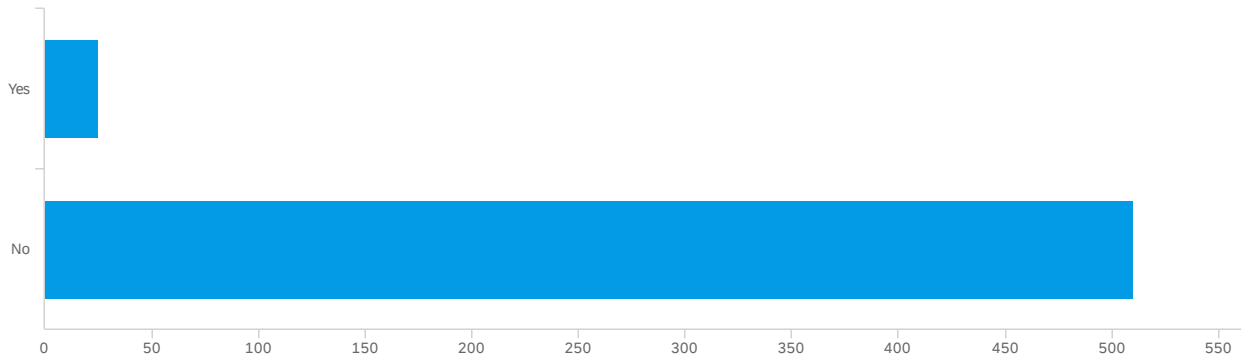

Q34 - Since the beginning of the current school year (fall 2020), have you observed a situation that you believed was, or could have led to, a sexual assault?

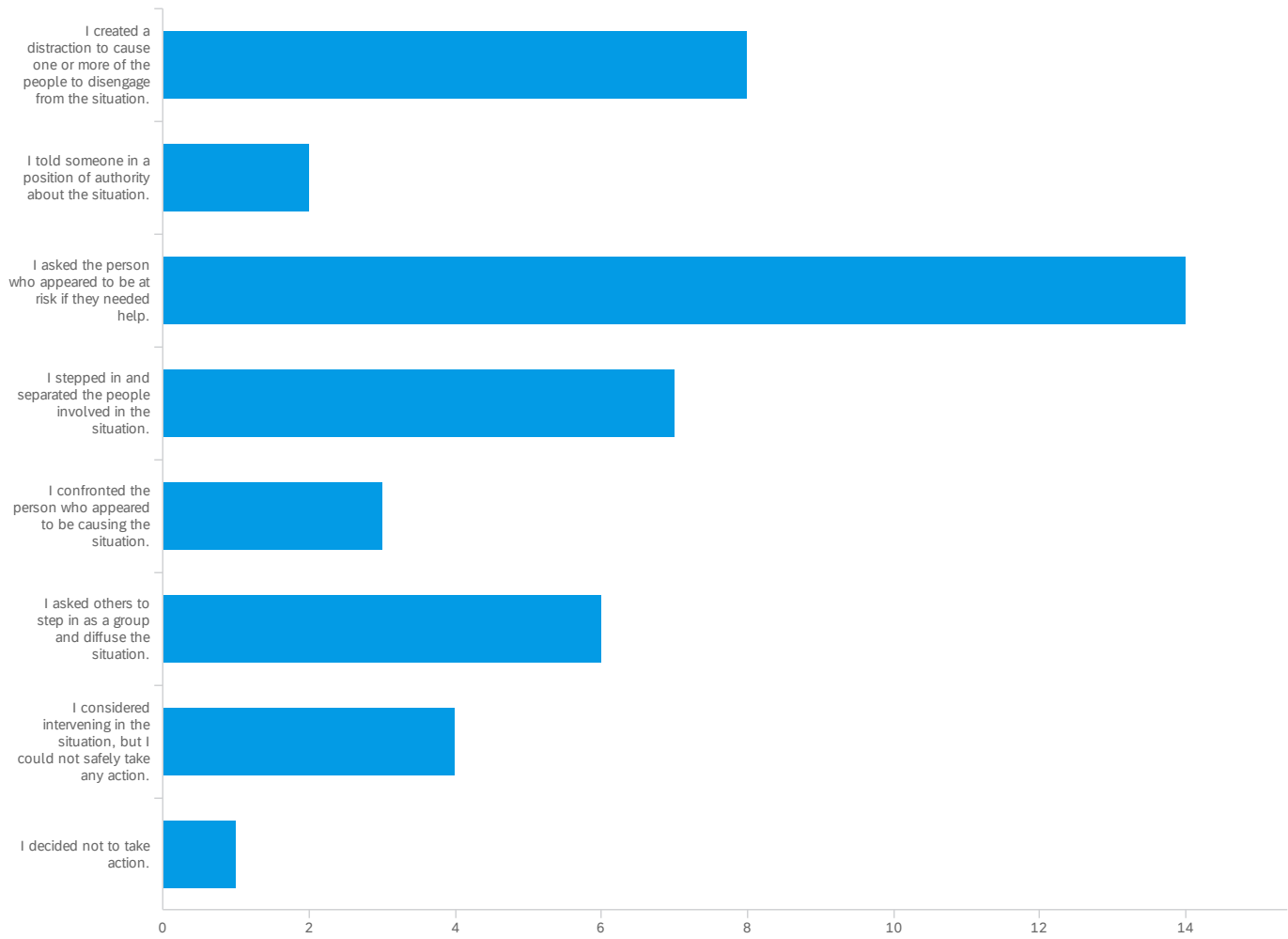

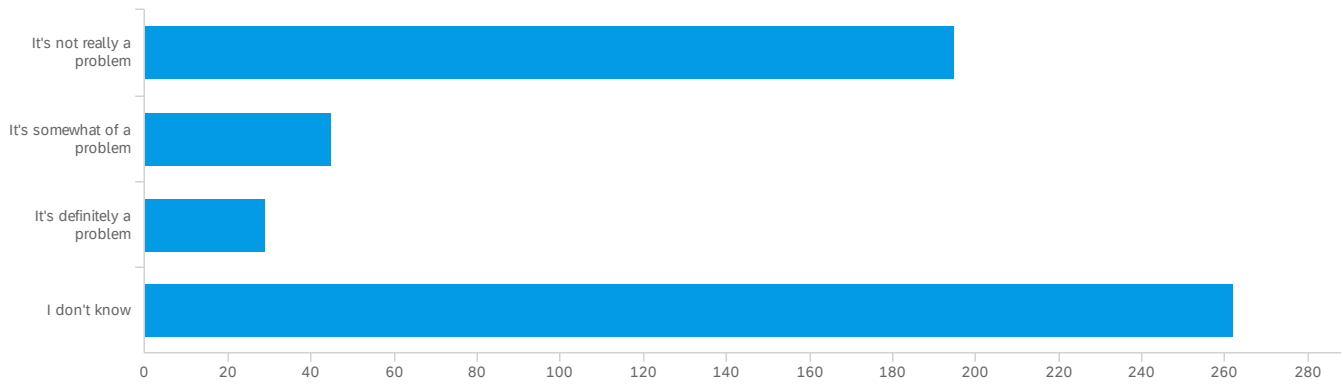

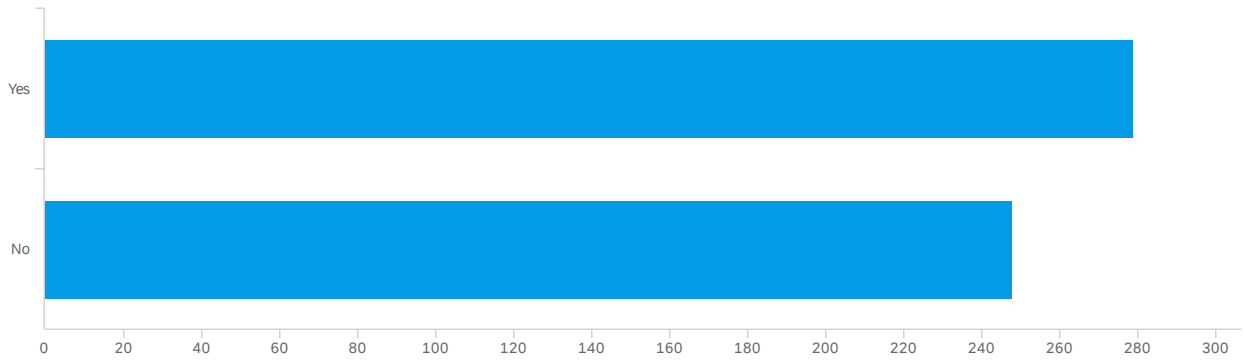
### Q36 - In your opinion, how much of a problem is sexual violence at your school?

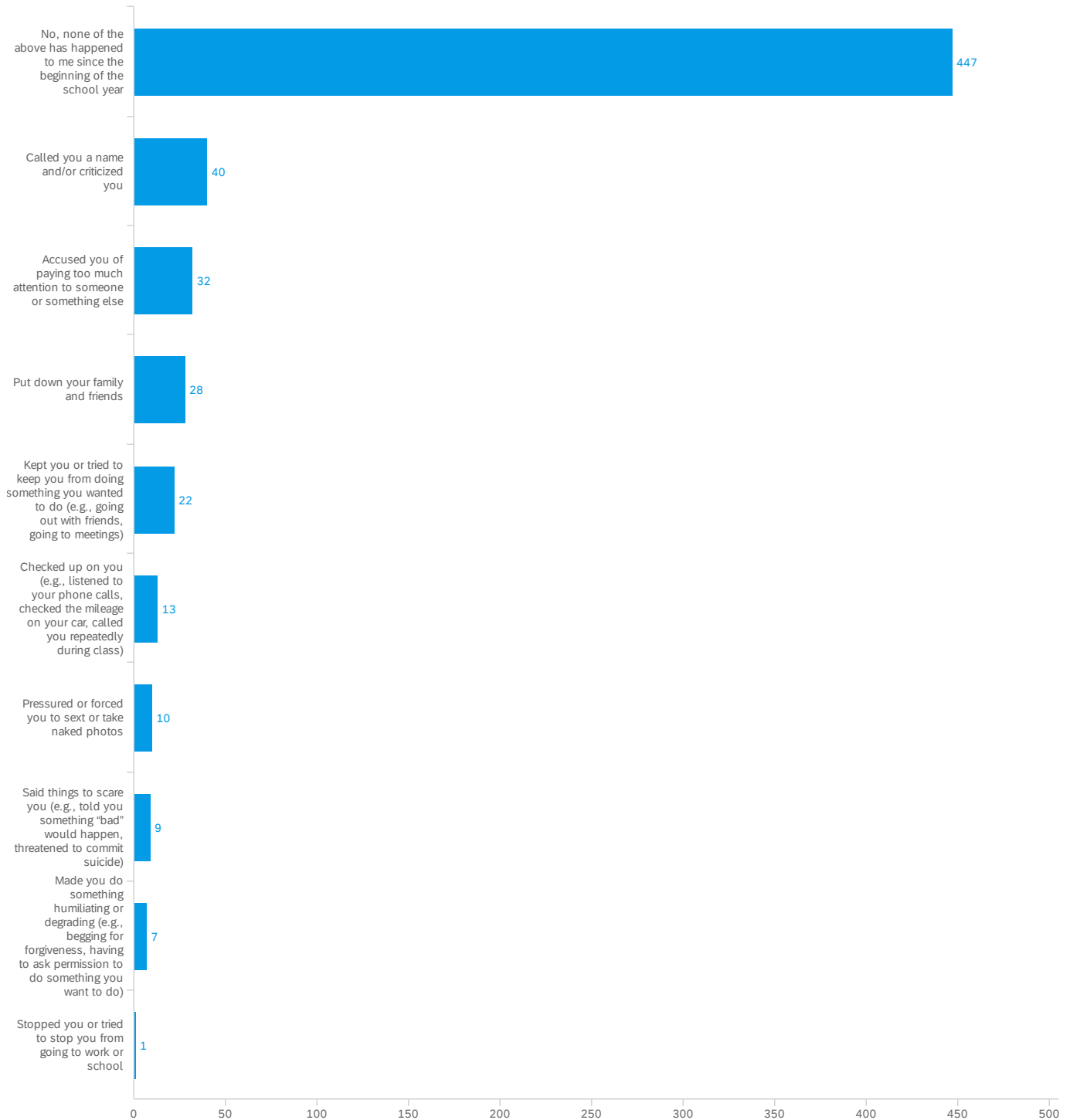

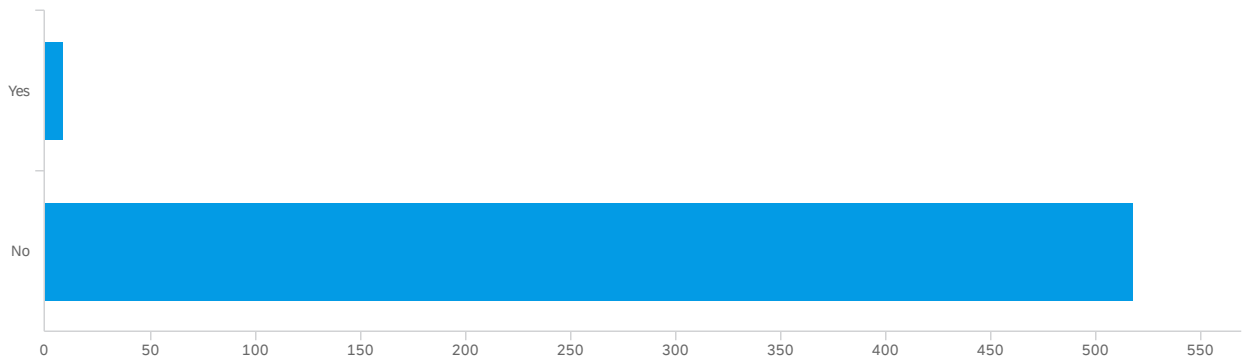

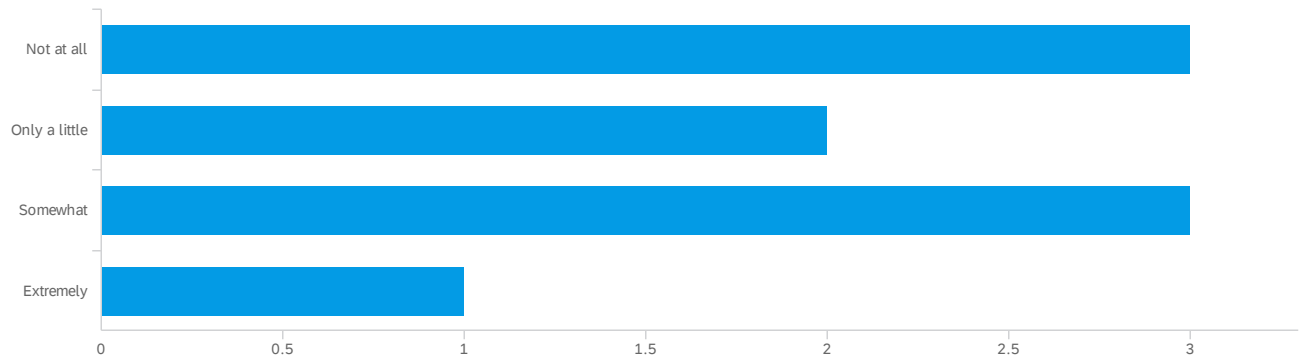

## Q40 - How concerned were you about your safety?



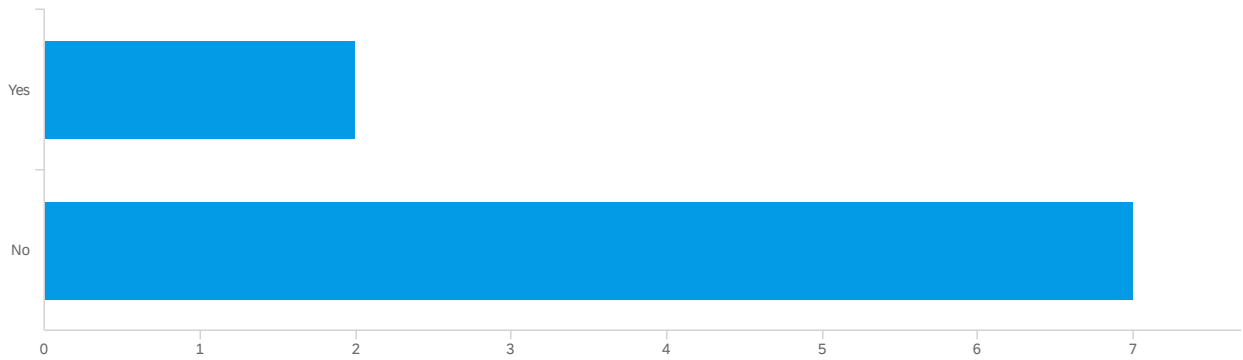

# Q41 - Did you seek services or contact a hotline after the incident?

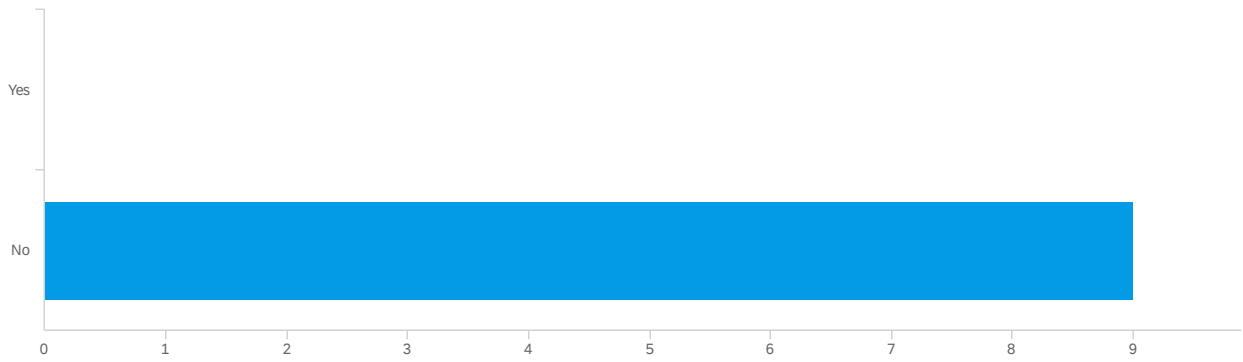

## Q42 - Were you physically injured in the incident?

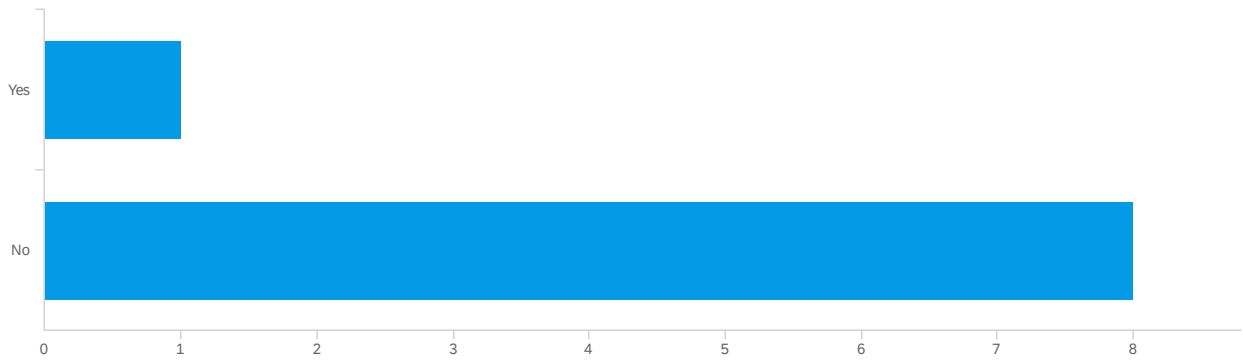

### Q43 - Did you seek medical attention?



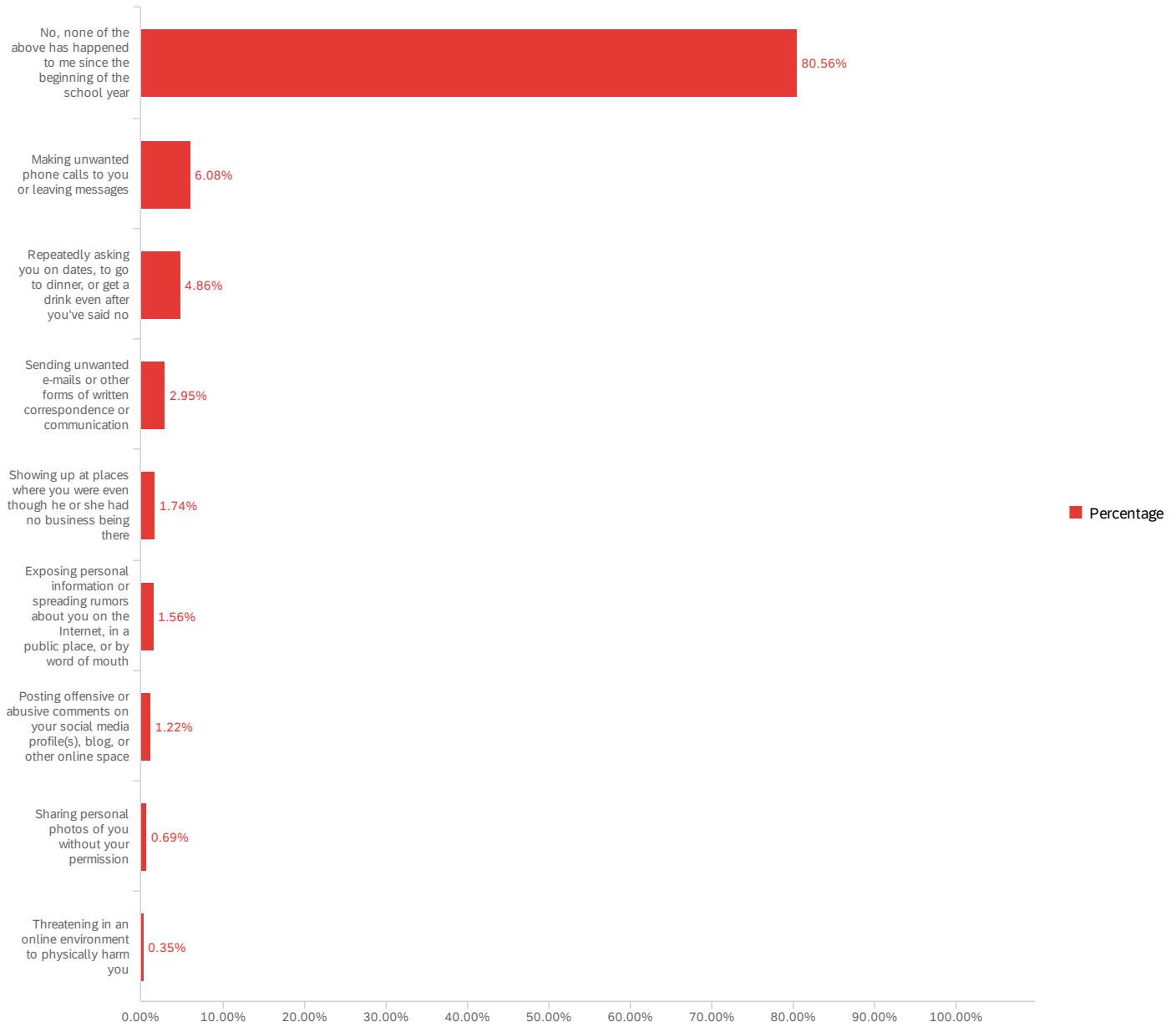

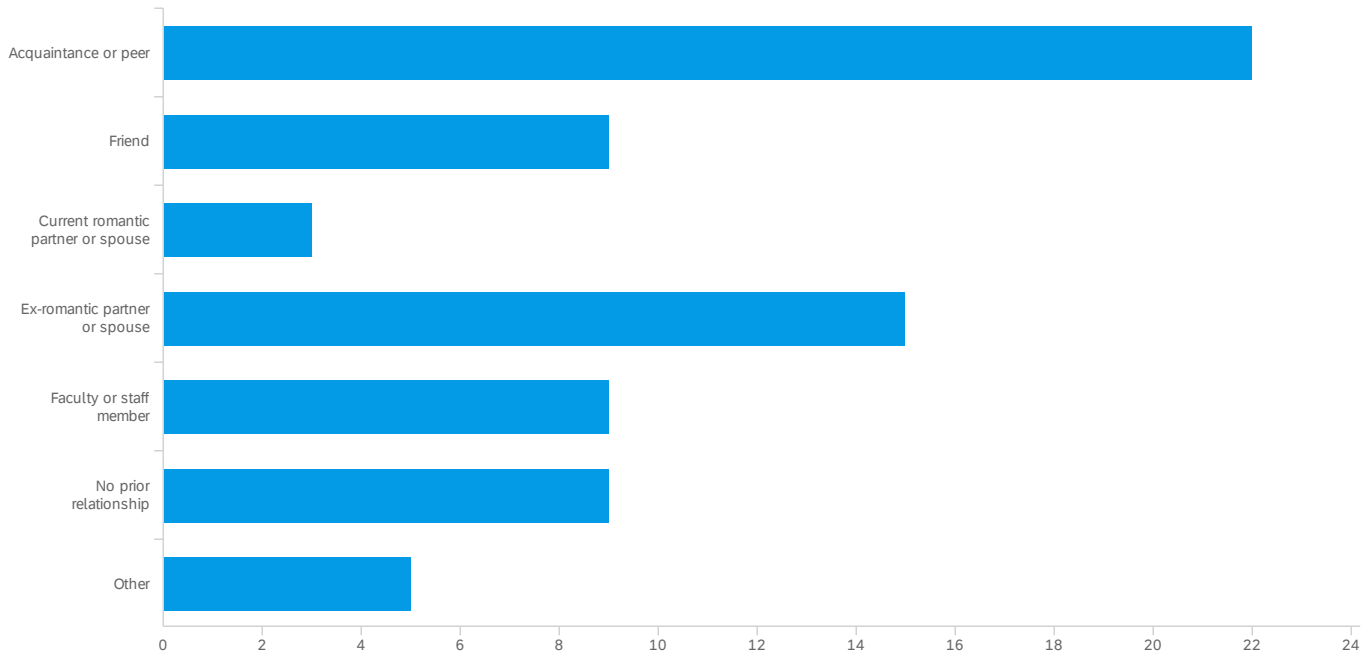

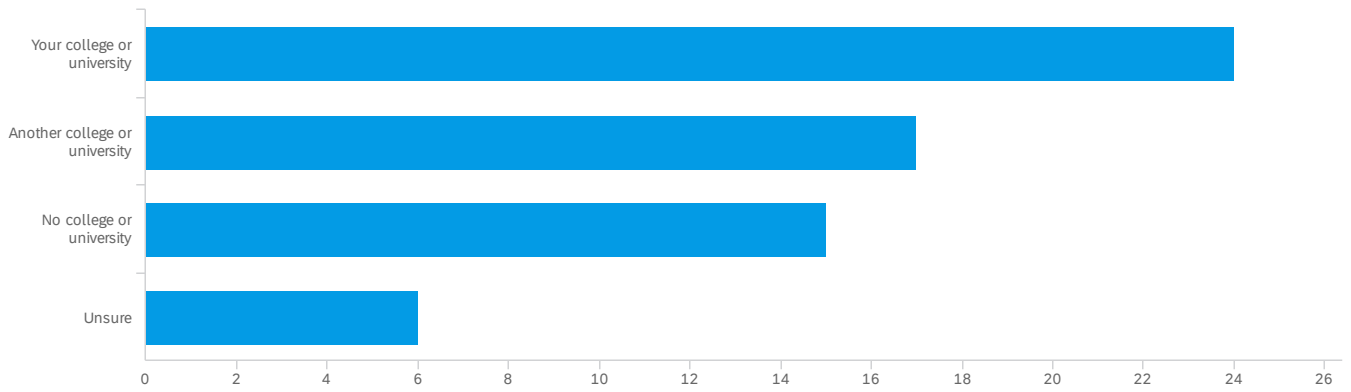

## Q46 - Was this person affiliated with:

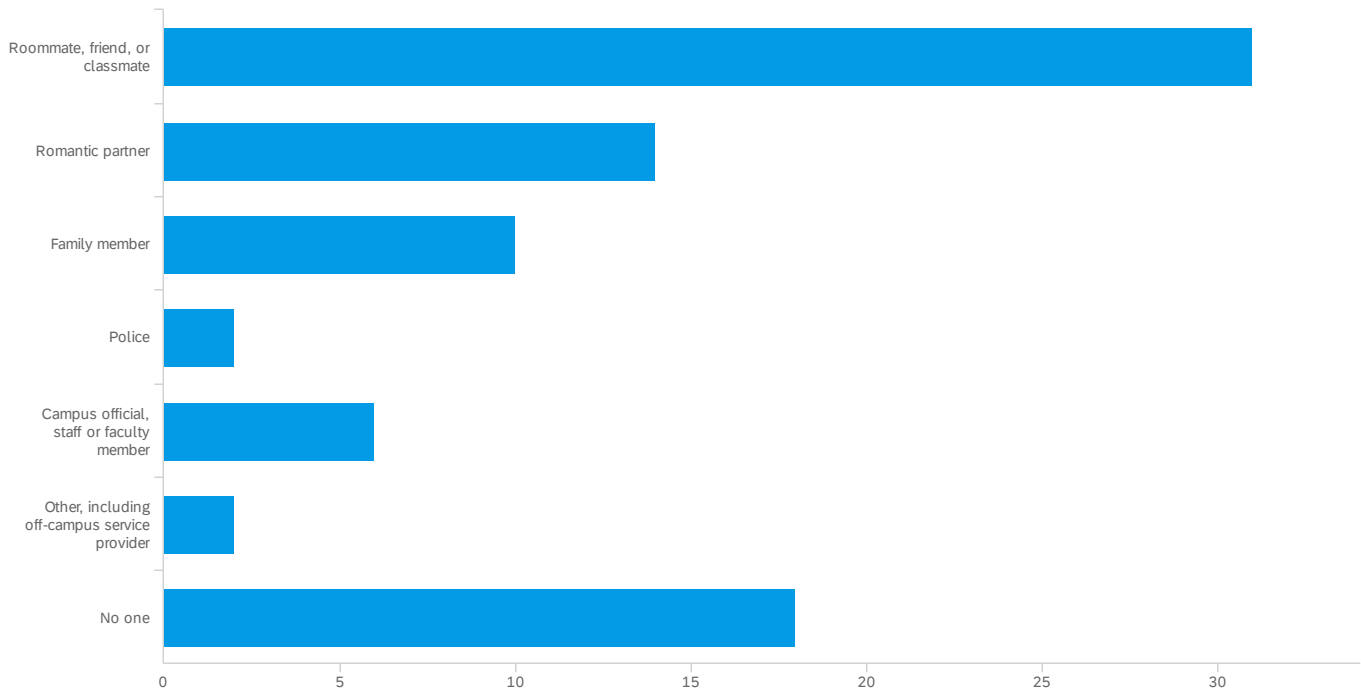

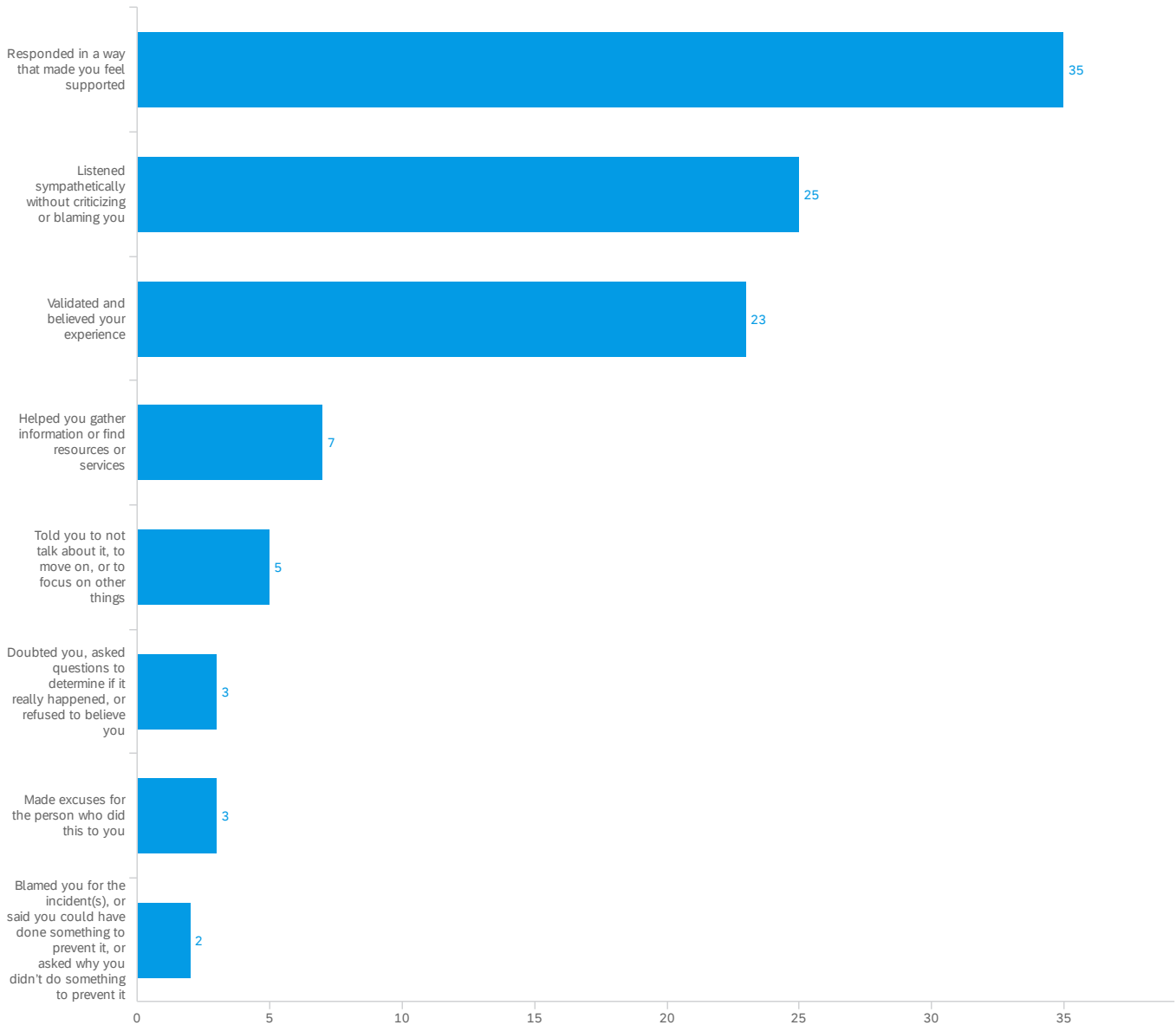

Q48 - What kind of responses did you receive from those you told or reported to? (select all that apply)



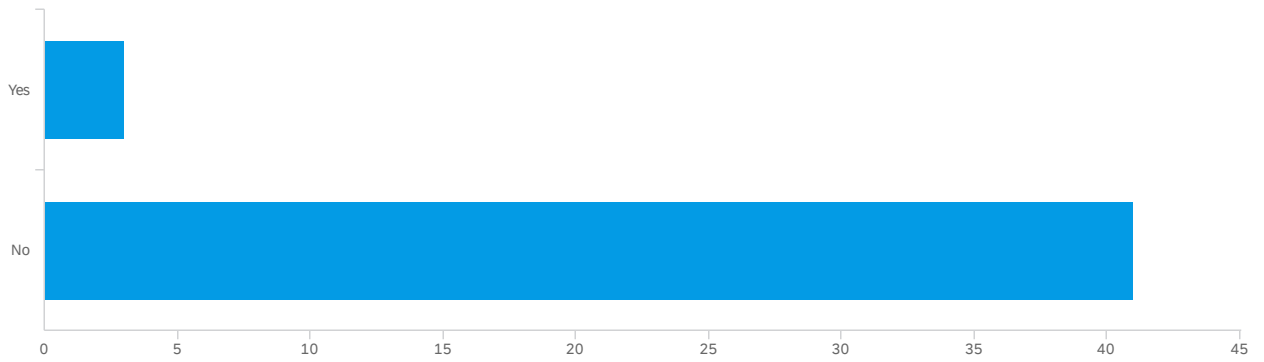

### Q49 - Did you use the school's formal procedures to report this incident(s)?

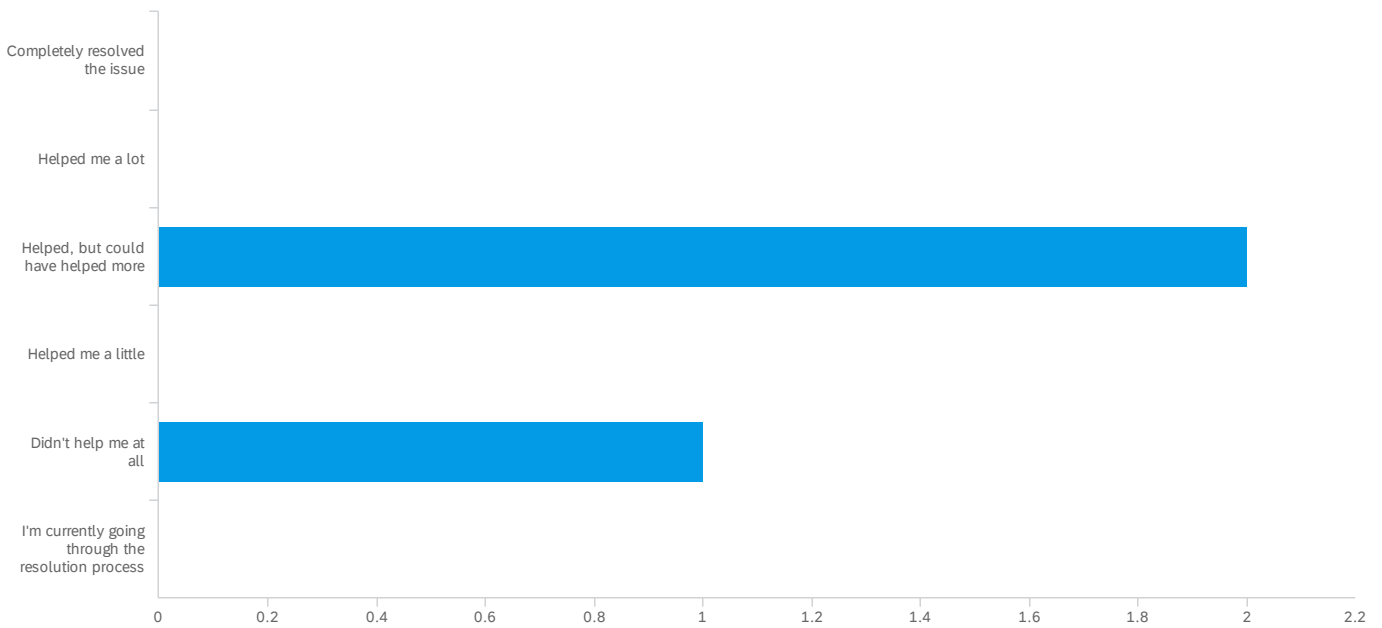
