#### What is Thank a Professor?

The CTL has launched a "Thank a Professor" initiative to enable students to recognize faculty members whose efforts helped create an outstanding experience for them. Students can send personalized messages to faculty, and each faculty member receives a letter and certificate with the student's message, with copies going to department chairs. Deans and vice presidents receive a summary listing all faculty recognized by the students, accompanied by selected messages from each school or college. We are sharing these notes with the permission of the students, and have removed any identifying information.

In the 2020-2021 academic year, 362 students completed 625 submissions, recognizing the hard work and dedication of 305 faculty members.
