New York Institute of Technology is proud to introduce the newest transfer scholarship available to qualified applicants. This transfer scholarship is intended for Phi Theta Kappa Honor Society members who intend to pursue a degree full time at New York Tech. Students are eligible to apply for this scholarship when they initially transfer into New York Tech.

Phi Theta Kappa's Scholarship will be awarded on a yearly basis to a select number of incoming transfer students. The amount is \$2,500 per year, and is renewable. Students who are awarded this scholarship must maintain a 3.5 GPA while attending New York Institute of Technology. This GPA will be checked each semester to ensure the students' eligibility.

In order to be considered, ALL of the following documents must be submitted no later than August 1: (December 1 for spring applicants)

- 1) Completed New York Tech application with all supporting documentation
- 2) Completed Phi Theta Kappa scholarship application
- 3) Proof of Active Phi Theta Kappa membership
 - a) "PTK Member" printed or stamped on your official college transcript, or
 - b) Letter from your chapter advisor
- 4) Please respond to the following question in a well-written essay of 300 to 500 words:

Please describe one other area in your life that you believe defines you as a person. How can New York Institute of Technology help to cultivate this area to make you a more well-rounded individual?
