Information Security/Privacy Council (ISPC)

Purpose

The Information Security and Privacy Council (ISPC) provides strategic guidance, direction and oversight on matters related to information security and data privacy. The ISPC is a standing committee. It advises the VP for IT/CIO on strategic direction for information security and for privacy programs; reviews security and privacy related policies, procedures, and operations; and helps to identify and prioritize potential areas of vulnerability and risk. The ISPC will:

- Assist in the identification of emerging administrative, technical and physical safeguard issues relative to information security and data privacy;
- Provide guidance, feedback and business level support for University-level information security and privacy initiatives, strategies, policies, standards and procedures;
- Promote the cultural and climate changes necessary to integrate information security and privacy standards and best practices into the University's mission critical operations of education, research, service and administration;
- Provide strategic input to key information security and data privacy initiatives;
- Provide guidance and support in matters of compliance and enforcement when violations of security and privacy
 policies, standards, and procedures are discovered and investigated; Represent the interests of the broader
 University community regarding the potential impact of security and privacy technologies, policies and other
 related initiatives; and
- Collaborate with IT staff, system owners and data managers to construct and sustain a secure and scalable technology environment.

Meeting Schedule

The ISPC meets 6 to 8 times per year. A majority of the members must be present to conduct a meeting.

ISPC is comprised of university leaders who are responsible for implementing information security and privacy policies and standards within their respective units.
