 Resource planning
- From a constituency perspective
 - Transactions processing systems (TPS) These systems record transactions and pass the information along to a database.
 - Management Information systems (MIS) These systems provide managers with the adequate information as and when required.
 - Decision support systems (DSS) These systems compile data into information and display the information in order to help managers make decisions.
 - Executive support systems (ESS) These systems provide highly summarized information regarding the organization which the executives can use as they look to come up with a long-term strategy for the company.

For this paper we analyze systems from a functional perspective, in addition we also list out examples of ERP, CRM and SCM.
