

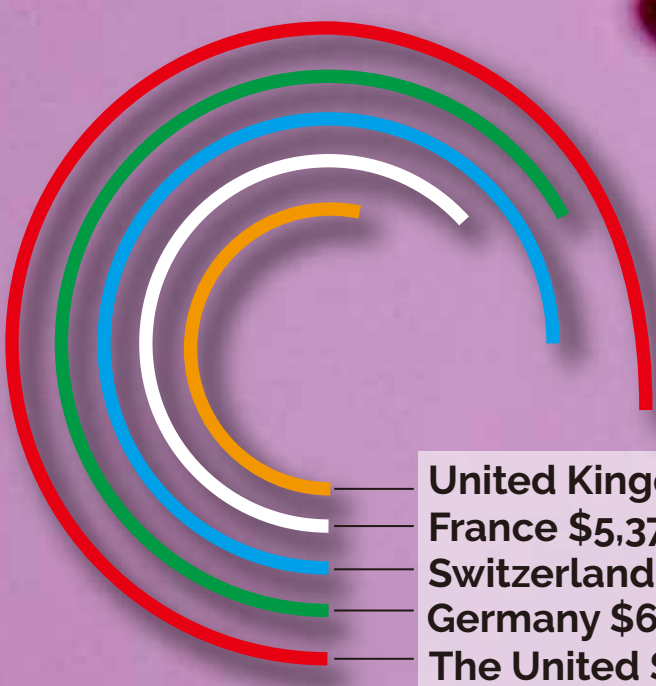

Total national health expenditures: \$3.6 trillion (2018)

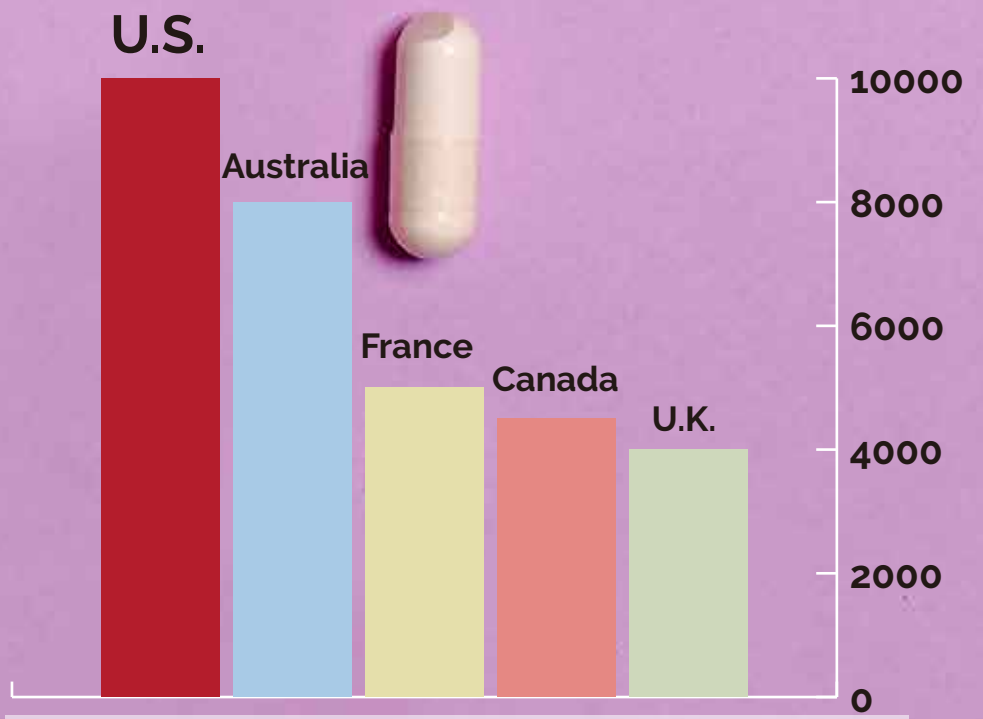
Per-cent of national health expenditures for hospital care: 32.7% (2018)

Per-cent of national health expenditures for prescription drugs: 9.2% (2018)

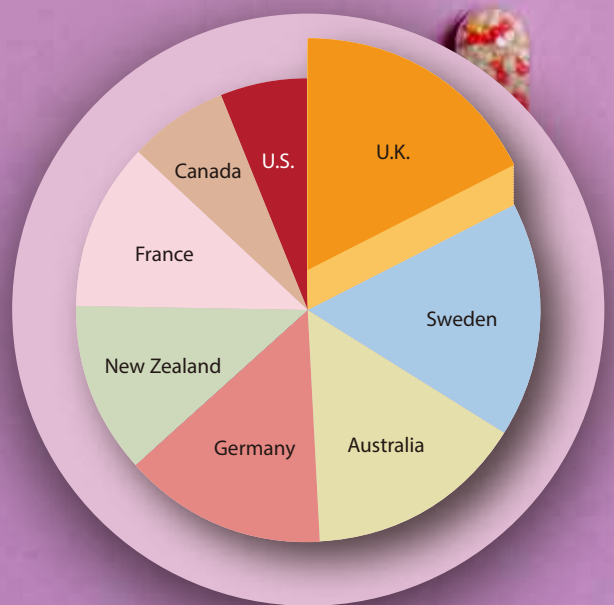


FAST FACTS OF HEALTH EXPENDITURES
